2021 Fixture Secretary Report

Despite the impact of Covid I believe the seasons fixtures provide a varied selection, maintaining a meaningful Order of Merit, a good number of team fixtures as well as providing for those not wishing to play in inter-club fixtures an opportunity to play competition golf.

With the challenge the restrictions we have in place provided it has been difficult to predict the attendances we could expect and to compensate this we have tended to lean towards team fixtures as replacements for cancelled fixtures as people have seemed more willing to turn out for these. That said I feel we have managed to achieve a good spread across all game types to cater for all tastes.

- Order of Merit qualifiers which include 4 quarterly and one final day medal competitions.
- 9 Inter-Club matches between April and October, only 6 of which impact Seniors Tuesday fixtures. On these Tuesdays Peter Roberts or a substitute will continue to run the alternate competition for those not involved in inter-club matches.
- Numerous team events. This includes 3 Seniors/Ladies matches (on Wednesdays) and also includes the Seniors Ryder Cup competition which will be played over 2 Tuesdays.
- Steve Lees arranged his Captains away day at Thonock Park, Gainsborough on Monday 5th July.
- Due to the restrictions in place, it was felt prudent to postpone the proposed 'Traveller Cup' for this season. We hope to be able to proceed with this next season provided there is sufficient interest.

In addition to the above, at our request, the Club have introduced a Senior Section pairs match play knock out competition where you select your own playing partner. This has proved popular and hopefully next year, with restrictions reducing, we will see more teams entering.

Our week-to-week competitions are only as good as their draws and I would like to thank Stuart Jones for the time and effort he puts in every week to ensure our competitions are played on as level a playing field as possible and that people get the opportunity to play with as many of the membership as possible. The system isn't perfect but it's not far off!
